



GT Urological, LLC Raises \$1 million

MINNEAPOLIS – GT Urological, LLC (GTU), a privately held medical device company of Minneapolis, has successfully raised \$1 million in its latest investment round that recently concluded. Funds will primarily be used to allow GTU to continue the development of its unique artificial urinary sphincter.

In addition to the latest successful investment round, GTU has commitments for another \$3 million that is conditioned on achievement of major company milestones in 2010 and 2011. Since the company's founding in 2003, GTU has raised more than \$4.1 million in private capital and \$2.2 million in Small Business Innovative Research (SBIR) grants from the National Institutes of Health.

"Raising capital in a challenging investor market shows the importance of our emerging product line," said Gerald W. Timm, GTU's founder and president. The U.S. incontinence market is estimated at 15 million people who annually spend an estimated \$2 billion on management products. The U.S. and worldwide markets are increasing with an aging population.

GTU is the developer of the ActiCuf Compression Pouch, a discreet disposable product for men whose light to moderate incontinence has often been treated with adult diapers.

In December, the ActiCuf received a reimbursement code from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), which facilitates reimbursement for purchases of the ActiCuf with a physician's prescription.
